Masilonyana is a category B municipality located in within Lejweleputswa district in the Free state.

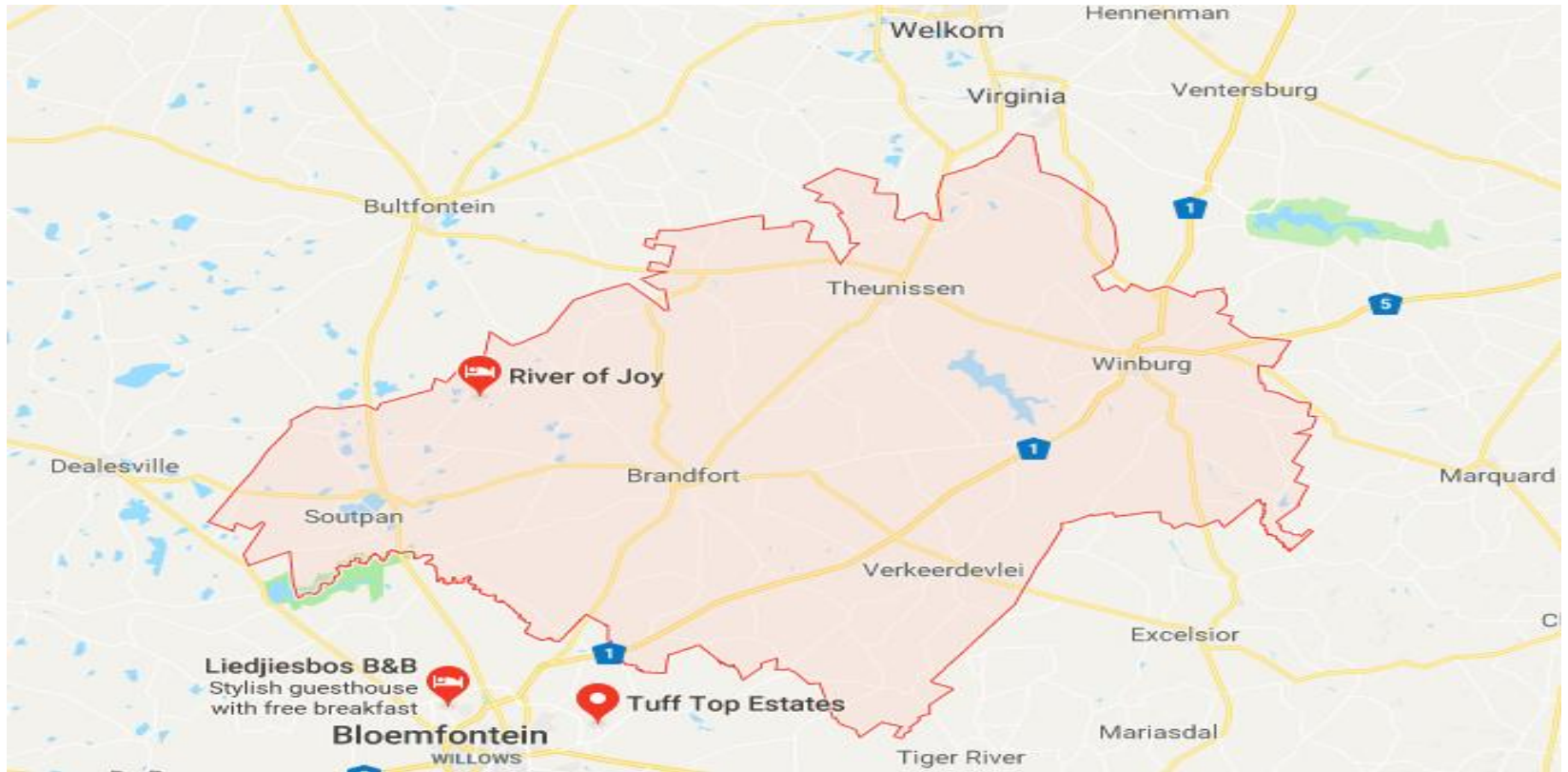
Area: 6618km

Wastage is the key issue that must be reduced:

- The current coal contracts in the news gives concern on how contracts are managed in Eskom. So why should we pay for these inefficiencies
- Has NERSA verified the correctness of the RCA application by Eskom. R66 Billion is a very large sum of money to claw back.
- Section 15(1) states that an efficient licensee can recover the full cost of applicable licensing activities, My municipality would like to know what happens if the licensee that distributes this power is inefficient.
