



Extension of deadline for public comments on Eskom's required Revenue Application – Multi-Year Price Determination 2010/11 to 2012/13 (MYPD 2)

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

On 30 November 2009 NERSA received a revised application from Eskom for an adjustment to the required revenue for the period 01 April 2010 to 31 March 2013 (MYPD 2).

NERSA has extended the deadline for comments until **14 December 2009** to enable stakeholders and the public to comment on the revised application.

Stakeholders are requested to comment in writing on Eskom's revised MYPD 2 application.
