

## **INVITATION TO COMMENT ON THE RULES FOR REGISTRATION OF SMALL SCALE EMBEDDED GENERATORS AND PROCESS IN TERMS OF ELECTRICITY REGULATION ACT, 2006 (ACT NO. 4 OF 2006)**

The National Energy Regulator (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The Energy Regulator's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

Stakeholders and members of the public are invited to comment on the consultation paper for the abovementioned rules for registration of Small Scale Embedded Generation (SSEG) and the registration process as required by the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004).
