



INVITATION TO COMMENT ON THE DRAFT AMENDMENT LICENSING EXEMPTION AND REGISTRATION NOTICE OF THE ELECTRICITY REGULATION ACT, AS REQUIRED BY THE NATIONAL ENERGY REGULATOR ACT

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA or 'the Energy Regulator') is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The Energy Regulator's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

Stakeholders and members of the public are invited to comment on the Consultation Paper and the Draft Amendment Licensing Exemption and Registration Notice, as required by the National Energy Regulator Act.
