

## **INVITATION TO COMMENT AND ATTEND PUBLIC HEARINGS ON TARIFF APPLICATIONS FOR PETROLEUM PIPELINE AND STORAGE FACILITIES**

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The Energy Regulator's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

The Energy Regulator invites the public to comment on the following tariff applications:

- **Sasol Oil (Pty) Ltd's** tariff application for its Secunda to Natref Integrated ('SNI') pipeline – 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019 tariff period;
- **Sasol Oil (Pty) Ltd's** tariff application for its petroleum storage facility located at Synfuels Road, Secunda, Mpumalanga - 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019 tariff period;
- **Sasol Oil (Pty) Ltd and BP Southern Africa (Pty) Ltd's** tariff application for their petroleum storage facility in Alrode, Gauteng - 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019 tariff period;
- **Engen Petroleum Ltd, Chevron South Africa (Pty) Ltd and BP Southern Africa (Pty) Ltd's** tariff application for their petroleum storage facility in Rustenburg – 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2018 tariff period;
- **Engen Petroleum Ltd, Chevron South Africa (Pty) Ltd and Total South Africa (Pty) Ltd's** tariff application for their petroleum storage facility in Witbank – 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2018 tariff period.
