

## **INVITATION TO SUBMIT WRITTEN COMMENTS AND TO ATTEND PUBLIC HEARING ON TRANSNET'S 2019/20 PETROLEUM PIPELINES SYSTEM TARIFF APPLICATION AND THE RELEVANT DISCUSSION DOCUMENT**

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA or 'the Energy Regulator') is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

On 1 August 2018, NERSA received Transnet SOC Limited's (Transnet) 2019/20 Petroleum Pipelines System Tariff Application. The tariff application and Energy Regulator's discussion document are available on the NERSA website at <http://www.nersa.org.za> under 'Invitation to Comment'.
