
INVITATION TO COMMENT ON TARIFF APPLICATIONS FOR PETROLEUM LOADING FACILITIES

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The Energy Regulator's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

The Energy Regulator invites the public to comment on the following tariff applications:

- **Transnet National Ports Authority's** tariff application for its Conventional Buoy Mooring (CBM) loading facility for the 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020 tariff period; and
- **Transnet National Ports Authority's** tariff application for its Single Point Mooring (SPM) loading facility for the 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020 tariff period
