

Storage Capacity Allocations Mechanism

1. Tariff Schedule:
 - a. Wozani Berg Gasoline does not have extra capacity for third party storage hence have not yet applied for a storage tariff from NERSA
2. Contractual terms and conditions:
 - a. The storage facility is based on a first come first serve basis and no preferential treatment will be given whatsoever.
 - b. Wozani Berg Gasoline will not discriminate between customers or classes of customers regarding access, tariffs, conditions or service except for objective justifiable and identifiable grounds approved by the Authority.
 - c. Storage and Handling will be handled as one entity.
 1. All storage and handling will be paid for in advance by EFT, and should the product not be removed in the specified period, then the stock will be sold off and the customer will be credited at WBG's cost price minus the storage costs. It is entirely up to WBG's discretion whether to extend the storage contract or sell off the product to recoup costs.
 - d. All other terms and conditions will apply as per WBG sales and conditions as per annexure 1.
 - e. Only 500ppm will be stored at this facility.
3. Technical requirements
 - a. vehicles and drivers:
 1. All vehicles will comply with the road traffic act and must be in a roadworthy condition.
 2. All vehicles will have a current License and road worth certificate.
 3. All vehicles must be D registered and comply with all hazchem requirements.
 4. All drivers will be subject to alcohol testing before entering the site.
 5. All drivers will have a valid Hazchem, medical, drivers license and dgp
 6. Drivers will wear safety shoes, coverall when entering the site and will wear gloves when loading, offloading or handling any product.
 7. Drivers will be required to sign in and out of the facility.
 - b. Loading and offloading.
 1. Loading will be done through the bulk meter and confirmed by dips from the bulk tanks.
 2. Offloading, product in the trucks will first be checked for temp and thereafter the product will be discharged through the bulk meter and confirmed by dips.
 3. Drivers WILL be present whilst offloading and loading and will at no time be allowed to leave the vehicle if the process has not been completed.
 - c. Facility.
 1. The facility will only store / handle 50ppm
 2. Only road transport is used as the facility is not linked to a pipe line.
 3. The facility can handle all vehicles up to 22m i.e. links and triaxles.
 4. Vehicles must be fitted with API 100mm male couplings, no other means of loading or off loading will be permitted.

4. Process to be followed when requesting access.
 - a. 3rd party will contact the depot manager in writing to request storage at least 2 weeks in advance. The manager will inform the 3rd party with in 7 days in writing after consulting with the Ops manager.
 - b. Once the storage is made available, then an order no with the volume, rate and duration is to be forwarded to the depot manager.
 - c. A schedule with driver, vehicle and volume to be forwarded to the manager at least 24hrs prior to loading/off loading.
