

NOTICE OF NERSA'S DECISION TO PUBLISH MUNICIPAL ELECTRICITY TARIFF APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2025/26 FINANCIAL YEAR

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), the Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and the Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

All tariff applications will be published on the NERSA website and social media platforms to solicit written comments from affected parties. NERSA's decision will be made, considering written comments from the affected stakeholders and analysis performed by NERSA officials.

NERSA invites all stakeholders to make their comments on the published tariff applications for the FY2025/26 to the following email address: municcomments@nersa.org.za on or before 06 June 2025.

NERSA has deviated from full consultation process in line with section 4(b) of PAJA which requires the following:

- a) The objective of the empowering provision
- b) The nature and purpose of, and the need to take, the administrative action.
- c) The likely effect of administrative action
- d) The urgency of taking the administrative action or urgency of the matter
- e) The need to promote an efficient and administration and good governance.
